Tickets to vote are 5 for \$1. Any art not desired to take home will served from 12:00-12:30. Any art not picked up by 12:45 will be given away or disposed.

The artist who receives the most votes will receive a gift basket of local business items. All proceeds will benefit Summer Reading Program and other programs for youth throughout the year.

Forms must be received by close of business Thursday July 1st at 7pm. Late entries will only be accepted if room permits.

Ground Rules:

- There will be a maximum of 50 contestants. So please pre-register.
- There is only one category for entrants - amateurs, professional, and group entries are welcome. One entry per person or entity.
- Entries must be produced in edible materials with the exception of small decorative items and structural elements (Pillars, cake board, wires).
- Each cake must fit into a display space of 24" x 24". No height limit.
- Small signs are permitted within the display area.
- There will be no refrigeration, electricity or running water available for individual displays.
- Ingredient Lists need to be submitted with your art - including any parts which can not be eaten.
- 90% of each display should be edible. Any art piece appearing to use more than 10% inedible objects will be displayed but not eligible for votes.
